

Post passport (international hour slip) for the southern branch (the route from Tromsø in Finmark to Mauno in Sweden) of the Haparanda post. The passport states that the mail was dispatched in a sealed mail sac on October 20th at 1 p.m., containing 1 parcel with letters to Lyngen (representing a local branch mail service), 1 parcel to Mauno and 1 parcel to Haparanda; the post passport is signed by sub-postmaster Lidstrøm in Mauno at 11 a.m. on October 25,1848, stating that the parcels to Mauno and Haparanda had arrived safely
