VADSØ

Vadsø got "kjøbstad" ownership in 1833. The post office was upgraded from a Class 3 to a Class 2 post office in 1856, and to a Class 1 post office in 1890. A 1-ring circular date-stamp was delivered on April 25th 1852 (type 1) and a numeral canceller "329" in August 1856
