Galten post office at the west coast of Sørøya in Finmark was established in March 1861 to serve this small settlement and arriving fishermen off the coast during the seasonal fisheries in spring and early summer. The mail was sent by a foot-and-boat branch mail service from Hammerfest. A year-round mail service was established in 1872
